- Geoffrey Dusheiko is Emeritus Professor of Medicine at the Royal Free Hospital and University College London School of Medicine and Consultant Hepatologist at Kings College Hospital London, in London, UK.
- Earned his MBBS degree from the University of Witwatersrand in Johannesburg, South Africa, Professor Dusheiko
- His fellowships were conducted at the Johannesburg Hospital Liver Unit and the National Institutes of Health, Maryland, and the University of Minnesota, USA.
- Professor Dusheiko's research interests include the management and treatment of HCV and HBV and small hepatocellular carcinoma; he has a special interest in research on viral hepatitis, especially viral genotyping, applied molecular virology, the natural history of chronic viral hepatitis and antiviral therapies.
- A member of several organisations, including EASL, AASLD and IASL, Professor Dusheiko is also a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians, the Royal College of Physicians of South Africa, and the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh.
- He previously served as Educational Councillor on the Governing Board of EASL for 4 years and was the recipient of the EASL Recognition Award in 2014.
