Research interests and publications:

He is interested in the field of chronic hepatitis B and C, and nonalcoholic fatty liver disease. His studies focus on the role of viral and host factors in the pathogenesis and natural/treatment outcomes of chronic hepatitis B and C, particularly the mechanism of hepatitis B acute exacerbation, the genotypes and phenotypes of HBV viral mutants, and the mechanism of HBsAg seroclearance. Besides, he has been actively involved in the clinical trials on the treatment of chronic hepatitis C, chronic hepatitis B, dual chronic hepatitis C and B, and HCC. He has published around 240 peer-reviewed papers.
